To the Honorable Board of Pardons

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April  
A. D. 1903, at Logan County of Cache  
and State of Utah, in the 1<sup>st</sup> Judicial district, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas H. Hart presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One Year  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Frank K. Heberer prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jacob Elie  
I was convicted under the name of Jacob Elie

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
