Application of Pardon

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of May A. D. 1914, at Utah County of Wasatch and State of Utah, in Fourth Dist. Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. B. Morgan presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Twenty months and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. H. Mc Donald prosecuted the case.
