and State of Utah, in The 3rd District court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Cannon presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable D. L. Eickman prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Moss Kifford
