I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Murder.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-Seventh day of May A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephrian Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Natural Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Gilbert Lang Brighton
I was convicted under the name of Gilbert Lang Brighton

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Angeline Wacaster, Roy Donnell

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE
