Application of Chas. Deakin

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of April A. D. 1909, at Logan County of Cache and State of Utah, in First Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Willard Mangham presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Eighteen (18) months and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable Dist. Atty. Hall prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Chas. F. Deakin I was convicted under the name of Chas. Deakin.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny.
