Application of Robert Mace No. _____

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the sixteenth day of July A. D. 1928, at Ogden Utah County of Wasatch and State of Utah, in the third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Carly N. Nesmith prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Robert Mace I was convicted under the name of Robert Mace
