Application of John William Owen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of December A. D. 1907, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George W. Armstrong presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 20 years Imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable F. C. Loofbourou prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John William Owen I was convicted under the name of John William Owen

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joseph Dullian
Joseph Garcia

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Ours
