under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A. D. 1901, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> judicial dist. court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Daniel W. Stewart residing.

Third—I was sentenced to Three (3) Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Dennis C. Eckert prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Laura Williams
