Application of Charles Daniel Murphy

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery & Attempt to Murder

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty Eight day of November A. D. 1910, at Tarrington County of Davis and State of Utah, in The Second District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Mr. Harris prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Charles Daniel Murphy I was convicted under the name of Charles Daniel Murphy

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except This one
