First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of June
A. D. 1898, at Castle Dale County of Cedar
and State of Utah, in The South District court in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jacob Johnson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Eight years imprisonment
commencing from said date
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
at Salt Lake County, State of Utah.

Fourth—Honorable Samuel A. King & Wm Howard prosecuted the case.
