Application of Valentine Manigero

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~pardon~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of Sept A. D. 1914, at Parowan County of and State of Utah, in 5th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. A. Greenwood presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 18 months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable W. H. Ryan prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Valentine Manigero I was convicted under the name of Valentine Manigero

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
