Application of Neut Little

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 3<sup>d</sup> degree.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1909, at Moab County of Grand and State of Utah, in 7<sup>th</sup> District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. N. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Six Months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable F. E. Woods prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Neut Little
