Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Chas Davis prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Graver Wilford Paulsen I was convicted under the name of Graver Wilford Paulsen
