Application of Charles Edwin Bigler jr

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Juab County jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of Battery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Com. Term 18th day of June A. D. 1910, at Yephi City County of Juab and State of Utah, in The Fifth Judicial District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Greenwood presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Six months imprisonment

Fourth—Honorable Harvey Cluff P. L. Fost prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Charles Edwin Bigler jr
I was convicted under the name of Charles Edwin Bigler jr

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except once at Yephi and once at Bureka for fistic fighting and was fined five dollars for each offense. I was not the aggressor in either occasion I simply defended my self after I had been struck
