I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake City
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Petit Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of February
A. D. 1913, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Criminal Div. City Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge G. H. Tanner presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve four (4) months
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County jail

Fourth—Honorable County Attorney Jensen prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Lewis C. Atwood
I was convicted under the name of Lewis C. Atwood

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Petit Larceny
