Application for Pardon

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Felony and Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August  
A. D. 1899, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> judicial district court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. V. Norrell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five (5) Years on each count  
but to run concurrent  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Abraham J. Putnam prosecuted the case.
