Application of Lionel Flowers

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of having carnal knowledge of a female over the age of 14 years and under the age of 18 years

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of May A. D. 1909, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable T. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to nine months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Lionel Flowers

I was convicted under the name of Lionel Flowers

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the one above stated
