Application of William Andrew Stotts (Bill Stotts) No.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petit larceny.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of July A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Judge Tanner's Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge N. H. Tanner presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to six months and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail.

Fourth-Honorable County Attorney Wallace Kelley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Andrew Stotts I was convicted under the name of Bill Stotts

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
