Application of A. O. Neilson.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of December A. D. 1914., at Vernal County of Uintah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan, presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of not to exceed ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable J. H. McDonald, prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Andrew Ole Neilson.

I was convicted under the name of A. O. Neilson.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
