Application of C. C. Jackson No. 5033

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Incest

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of May A. D. 1928, at Brigham County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable LeRoy Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is C. C. Jackson I was convicted under the name of C. C. Jackson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
