Application of Tracy Driskell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Furnishing implements to escape prisoner

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of February A. D. 1910, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. D. Lewis presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One year

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable W. C. Hoffmann prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Tracy Orosia Driskell
I was convicted under the name of Tracy Driskell

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above
