Application of Ben Jarratt
Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglar in the 2nd degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th Sept day of 1908 A. D. at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 1st Judicial County court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Rematizing presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 3 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary at Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth—Honorable J. C. Sutherland prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Ben Jarratt
I was convicted under the name of Ben Jarratt

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
