Application of Roland H. Hipson

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Commutation} and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of burglary in the second degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of June A. D. 1907, at Castle Dale County of Emery

and State of Utah, in the seventh judicial court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ferdinand E. Erickson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable F. E. Woods prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Roland H. Hipson

I was convicted under the name of Roland H. Hipson
