Application of Pardon for Robert Turner

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Fillmore city Jail or County Jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of Petty Larceny.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of November A. D. 1909, at Fillmore city, County of Millard, and State of Utah, in the (5) fifth judicial district court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joshua Greenwood presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to serve 4 months in the Fillmore city Jail, or County Jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Fillmore city Jail since the 18 day of November 1909.

Fourth—Honorable E. H. Ryan, District Atty, prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Robert Turner. I was convicted under the name of Robert Turner.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this case, the one that I am now serving the 4-months on for the charge of Petty Larceny.
