Application of Jesse Rice

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a commutation and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglar in second Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of 1906 A. D. Second, at Ogden Utah — County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. O. Casswell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to 3 years to Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. W. Harris prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jesse Rice I was convicted under the name of Jesse Rice

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this charge.
