First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah penitentiary,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the _____ day of _____
A. D. 1898, at Monticello County of San Juan
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District court in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jacob Johnson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of three years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah Penitentiary, where I
have remained ever since

Fourth—Honorable Mr. Patlock & George Adams prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Oscar Foy
I was convicted under the name of Oscar Foy

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I
now seek a pardon from your honorable body.
