Application for Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons  
of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the state penitentiary  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the seventh day of September  
A. D. 1897, at Randolph County of Rich  
and State of Utah, in First Judicial District court in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Charles H. Hart presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary  
for a period of eight years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable David Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Miskimins  
I was convicted under the name of William Johnson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:  
David Jones and Charles Ferguson

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except that of petit larceny  
which conviction was before a justice of the peace in Tooele City,  
Tooele County, State of Utah, on or about the 10th day of April, 1896.
