To the Honorable Board of Pardons

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May  
A. D. 1890, at Heber City County of Wasatch  
and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial Dist court in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jno E. Booth presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to One (1) Year  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. A. King prosecuted the case.
