Application for Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Penitentiary,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Embezzlement

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of January
A. D. 1899, at Logan County of Cache
and State of Utah, in the First Judicial District court in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chas. H. Hart presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to one year imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable Frank K. Nebeker prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John H. Gill
I was convicted under the name of J. H. Gill

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
