Application for Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons
of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon

and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison, under conviction and sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of October A. D. 1896, at Logan, County of Coche and State of Utah, in the first Judicial District court in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hart presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to two years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Samuel Rich prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Edginton. I was convicted under the name of William Edginton.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:
Anna Nelson

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one having never been accused, or accused of crime before.
