Application for Pardon.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons

of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon

and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of November A. D. 1898, at Ogden, County of Weber, and State of Utah, in the 2nd Judicial Dist. court in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry A. Polapp presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Prison 7 Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable A. Weber prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Thomas Lacey I was convicted under the name of Thomas Lacey

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except as above stated
