Application for ^{Jordan} Commutation of Sentence under Coffey act

To the Honorable Board of Pardons

of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Jordan} Commutation of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of June A. D. 1898, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third District court in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. G. Howell presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to a term of one year in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on the 25th Day of June 1898

Fourth—Honorable G. F. Putnam prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George King I was convicted under the name of George King

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except As above stated
