Application for Pardon.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of June

and State of Utah, in Thos. H. Wilson, Justice court in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thos. H. Wilson presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Five months in the
county jail at Provo, Utah County,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the said county jail.

Fourth—Honorable Jacob Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jacob Wilson
I was convicted under the name of Jacob Wilson
