Application for Commutation of Sentence

To the Honorable Board of Pardons
of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in waiting, in the State Prison,
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Murder in the First degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of October,
A. D. 1895, at Ogden City County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District court in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George W. Bartch presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to be shot until dead
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable W. C. Maguire & J. J. Richards prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Patrick Coughlin
I was convicted under the name of Patrick Coughlin

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:
Fredrick George,

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except One Year for Burglary
from 3rd Dist Court April 10th 1891 in the
Utah Penitentiary
