Application of Ray Hall

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of Feb. A. D. 1917, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. A. Pratt presiding

Third—I was sentenced to An Indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable S. P. Holtz prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Ray Hall
I was convicted under the name of Ray Hall
