First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of October A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Stephen E. Hartsell. I was convicted under the name of Stephen E. Hartsell.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Fred Templeton and James Alexander.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
