Application of Agustin Aguirre

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of January A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wight presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to from One to Ten Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Agustin Aguirre I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Wicho Marias (released)

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except First Offence
