Application of Harold Loman.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole -  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A. D. 1921, at Duchesne County of Duchesne  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hansen presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to serve from 1 to 2.5 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth -- Honorable Chas G. Walquist prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Harold Loman.  
I was convicted under the name of Harold Loman.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
