Application of John Samson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of unlawful possession of intoxicating liquor.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the tenth day of October A. D. 1921, at Provo City County of Utah and State of Utah, in the City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Tucker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to pay a fine of \$299.00 or serve 90 days in the Utah County Jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah County Jail.

Fourth-- Honorable M. R. Straw prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Samson I was convicted under the name of same as above

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
