Application of John Jackson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of Jan A. D. 1921, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George Barber presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an insufficient term of from One to Twenty 1-20 yrs and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City.

Fourth-- Honorable Prosattly Joe Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Jackson I was convicted under the name of John Jackson
