Application of Forest Mohlman.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the County Jail of Weber County, Utah, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Fornication.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of October A. D. 1921, at Ogden City, County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve six (6) months imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Weber County, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Forest Mohlman I was convicted under the name of Forest Mohlman

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
