Application of Joseph Sullivan

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Murder

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of April A. D. 1908, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Armstrong presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Lucas B. Safford prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Joseph Sullivan I was convicted under the name of Joseph Sullivan

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: John Owens

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Assault with deadly weapon, & Jail Break
