Application of Henry Rickenberg

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Violation Probation Law.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Thirtieth day of June A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve 90 days and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Henry Rickenberg I was convicted under the name of Henry Rickenberg

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: There was no one charged jointly with me.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a prior conviction for having intoxicated liquor in my possession.
