Application of James Potter

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of April A. D. 1921, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephriam Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Walmquist prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Potter I was convicted under the name of James Potter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Edward Miller (has been release since)

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
