I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination.
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in On Parole Since Sept. 24th.
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Rec. Stolen Goods.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 rd. day of March.
A. D. 1921. at Salt Lake City. County of Salt Lake.
and State of Utah, in 3 rd. Dist. Court. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L.B. Wight. presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E.A. Rogers. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is W.C. Parker.

I was convicted under the name of W.C. Parker.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Jimmie Herald, Frank Murphy, Charles Morris.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.

I am applying for a Termination, so that I will be able to
re-enlist in the United States Army, at Ft. Douglas. The
Commanding Officer at the fort will gladly let me re-enlist
if the Board of Pardons will terminate me.
