County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joshua Greenwood. presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Twenty years.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable E. H. Ryan. prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Elmer Horton.
I was convicted under the name of William Elmer Horton.
