Application of Fernando Rodriguez

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Express Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 11 day of September
A. D. 1916, at Bingham City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to 6 years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. C. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Fernando Rodriguez

I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: Aguilino Arcande and

Joe Troncone

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this charge
