Application of Orville Hopkins

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd. Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of January A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd. Dist. Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six Months to Three Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Dist. Attorney Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Orville Hopkins I was convicted under the name of Orville Hopkins

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: N. O. N. E.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except N. O. N. E.
