Application of Bruce Blair

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of September A. D. 1917, at Ogden, County of Uintah and State of Utah, in The Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Three Six Months term of years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. H. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Bruce Blair I was convicted under the name of Same name as above

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: There was no one connected with me in this case

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this offense

I suppose I have to Apply for Termination This August meeting as my first Application was sent in at the February meeting
