Application of William F. Boyd

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Sept  
A. D. 1917, at Tooele Utah County of Tooele  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Louis Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Toe and such termination sentence  
in the Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable W. South Castle prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Franklin Boyd  
I was convicted under the name of Boyd

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same  
offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except A Military  
Offense under Article 17  
of 17<sup>th</sup> Article of War Was tried at  
Fort D. A. Russell Mont on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of  
Sept 1913 sentenced to Seven Months Pen  
for 1 year
